Terminal Name	Forcados Terminal
Terminal Description	<p>The offshore terminals are operated by Shell Petroleum Development Company and are situated 23km from shore. They serve the Forcados oil terminal of SPDC, through which crude export has been handled since 1973.</p> <p>There are currently 2 operational SPM's known as Forcados No 1 and Forcados No 2. A third SPM, originally operational from 1973, is now maintained and held in reserve.</p> <p>Both buoys are of CALM design. Forcados No 1 was installed in 1986 and Forcados No 2 was installed in 1989. Both buoys are in water depths of around 25 metres.</p> <p>Tankers from 45,000 Tonnes DWT up to 320,000 Tonnes DWT can be handled at the SPM's</p>
Lamnalco Scope of Work	
Personnel	In line with Lamnalco Group's commitment to indigenisation we employ 84 Nigerian nationals plus shore staff and management on this contract.
Equipment	As part of the contract Lamnalco delivered 3 newbuild tugs of Damen 2608 design customised to Charterers requirements. In addition, 2 newbuild crewboats were also provided.
Services	Lamnalco provides Pilotage, tanker inspection, berthing and un-berthing, and loading services and maintains onshore camp and workshop facilities at Forcados terminal.
Period of work	Lamnalco has operated at Forcados since 1992.
